

# Do Dah Day 2010

## Vendor Rules and Regulations

Do Dah Day will be held on Saturday, May 15, 2010 in Rhodes and Caldwell parks, located between the 2800 and 3100 blocks of Highland Avenue South, on Birmingham's Southside.

Parks will be open for vendors beginning at 7:30 am. Automobile and other vehicular traffic is prohibited in the parks. DDD staff with golf carts will be available to assist you in ferrying merchandise in and out of the parks. Vendors should be ready for business by 10:00 am.

Festival hours are advertised from 11:01am until 6:01pm. There will be early traffic to your booth, but there will be a quick, timely breakdown beginning at 5:01pm in Rhodes park, and 6:01pm in Caldwell park. You may bring a 10x10 tent, table and chairs for your display.

Park maps will be posted on the website in early May. Please check-in at the designated locations, and Do Dah Day staff will escort you to your booth location. Please post all applicable licenses at your booth. Parking can become a problem after 10:00 am, so arrive early to secure a convenient space on the streets surrounding the parks.

All deliveries to the parks must be cleared by Do Dah Day in advance, and must pass through designated vendor entrances ONLY. Security will allow you to park and unload, but cars left unattended for more than 15 minutes will be towed at owner expense.

All food vendors will be sent a form to fill out and return to the Jefferson County Health Dept. **BE SURE TO SEND IT TO THEM.** Failure to do so is a Health Dept. violation, and may result in eviction from the park. Deposits to Do Dah Day will not be refunded in case of such an event. Also, if you are cooking food, the Fire Marshall will inspect your booth before opening.

We will send you the regulations in advance. Do Dah Day is not responsible if codes and regulations are not met, and deposits will not be refunded.
